

## Rules and Regulations

#### **ENTRIES:**

Entries will close on Monday, August 8, 2016. Horses shown in classes in which they have not entered will be required to pay DOUBLE entry fee for those classes. Entry blanks will only be accepted when signed appropriately and accompanied by a check for stabling fees. All horses/ponies entered must show proof of current negative Coggins test before entry will be accepted. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. Entries are to be sent to the show secretary at the address on the entry form.

Entries will also be accepted through horseshowing.com. The website is charging \$3 to use the site for entering the MHJA show. Any entries submitted through horseshowing.com will be credited the \$3 website fee when checking out at the show.

#### **STABLING:**

10X10 permanent wood stalls with doors. Stabling will be available at \$100.00/weekend if pre-paid. The charge will be \$115.00 if fees are not received by Monday of the show week. BEDDING is available for purchase at \$8.50/bag. Requests for bedding should be included on your entry form. Stalls will be available on Thursday, the day before the show, at 3:00 PM. STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE HELD WITHOUT PAYMENT. Stall fees are NOT REFUNDABLE. Reservations and fees must be received no later than Monday of the show week. PLEASE CALL OR E-MAIL DOTTIE LOS TO CONFIRM STALL RESERVATIONS - dotlos2003@yahoo.com or 724-991-2427. A fee of \$30.00/horse will be charged to all day shippers whether showing or not.

Day stalls are \$45.00/day (6:30AM until 7:00PM), if available. Priority is given to weekend stabling. Check with Dottie for availability.

#### **PARKING:**

Vans, trailers, trucks, and cars must park in designated areas only. Wet ground conditions may prohibit or limit parking on all areas of the show grounds. PLEASE COOPERATE with the organized parking out of consideration to others and keeping the show grounds safe and accessible at all times. Do not park in stable area-FIRE AND COUNTY RULING. A special area will be designated for all Day Shippers showing off their trailers.

#### **About MHJA**

The Mountaineer Hunter Jumper Association was founded in 1998 to promote riders in the tri-state area that show on the local level. Our mission is to instill a foundation for riders to help further their knowledge and involvement in the horse community and promote a healthy approach to competition.

We sanction many hunter/jumper shows on our circuit. Shows sanctioned by MHJA in 2016 include: The Sewickley Hunt, Harlansburg, PA; Horse Sports, Fairview, PA; Erie Hunt & Saddle, Fairview, PA;

Equisports, Reedsville, WV; Horse on Course, Saxonburg, PA: Chagrin Valley Farms, Chagrin Falls, OH: and Up and Over, Canfield, OH.

In 2004, MHJA hosted its first Endless Summer Schooling Show, and it was a great success with over 120 entries! And 2014 topped all expectations with more than 180 entries! This event is an opportunity for members to receive double points in the divisions for which they are nominated.

Our year-end awards banquet in December honors all our members and recognizes their accomplishments throughout the year. Members are presented with trophies and ribbons for their placings in their selected divisions. Our members represent a broad spectrum of individuals ranging from professionals and adult amateurs to junior riders. Our recognized divisions range from Walk-Trot and Beginner Riders to Adult Amateur and Open Hunters and in Jumpers - from Puddle Jumpers to Schooling Jumpers. We also award points in the Equitation Divisions.

#### **CAMPER HOOK-UPS:**

Camper hook-up pads are available at \$75.00 for the weekend. Reservations and fees must be received by Monday of the show week. Contact Dottie Los (see contact info above) to make reservations. Space is limited.

#### **CREDENTIALS:**

No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. Any Children's Pony Hunter must have size checked on entry blank.

#### **MANAGEMENT:**

The horse show management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry.

#### **REFUNDS:**

No stall fees will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes they have entered forfeit the entry fees, except if a horse becomes ill prior to the class entered. Scratches must be made prior to the start of the class and must be accompanied by a certificate from the show vet. Scratches and refunds will be charged a \$10.00 processing fee.

#### **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:**

All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field, such as, but not limited to: brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, and panels. All Equitation classes will be judged on seat, hands, and guidance and control of the mount.

Six ribbons will be presented in all classes. A Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded and presented to two of the top four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter/jumper section. In addition to these points, only those horses will receive full points for one under saddle class.

Management reserves the right to limit the courtesy circle in Hunter and Equitation classes.

Management reserves the right to change any table or height (within the division rules) or ring location in the jumper or hunter classes to accommodate weather conditions or competitors showing. Also, divisions/classes may be split or combined, at management's discretion due to division/class size.

#### **JUMPING ORDER:**

A rotating jumping order may be established for all classes over fences. Management reserves the right to draw and post an order of go. Riders or trainers with conflicts must see the starter so necessary adjustments can be made.

#### **PRIZES:**

Prizes will be awarded as noted. Prize money will be credited to show accounts, and remaining prize money checks will be mailed.

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES-NO EXCEPTIONS.
- NO SMOKING permitted around stabling areas.
- All riders must wear ASTM approved protective headgear whenever mounted.
- All riders must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the ring.
  - \*Refer to USEF Rulebook for Hunters, Jumpers, and Equitation\*
- A processing fee of \$40.00 plus collection fees will be charged for any non-negotiable checks.
- Show Ring A is 150x255 sand footing. Show Ring C is 150x190, sand footing.
- Two warm up rings (B and D) are sand footing.
- No alterations are to be made to permanent stabling or other facilities by exhibitors.
- Owners & Exhibitors shall be held responsible for damages on the show grounds and stalls incurred by them, their horses, agents, employees, guests, etc. and will be billed for same.
- Any minor must have a valid driver's license issued by their state of residence in order to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds.
- No golf carts are to be charged/plugged into electric in stabling area.
- All horses brought to the facility (whether showing or not) are responsible for providing the show office with a signed entry form, current Coggins, and payment of the Grounds, Ambulance and Stall/Day Shipper Fees.
- Number of fans used will be limited. A FAN PER HORSE IS NOT PERMITTED.
- Non-showing horses stabled at the show will be charged a \$40.00 non-showing fee.
- Concessions will be available on show days.

#### **SCHOOLING:**

Schooling will be permitted on Thursday after 3:00pm until dark in Rings A and C.

Friday morning until 7:30 in Ring A and Ring C. Schooling MAY permitted at the conclusion of the show and course building, in both rings on Friday and Saturday until dark, at management discretion.

Saturday and Sunday mornings Ring A will be open until 7:15 am. Ring C will be open until 7:30 am.

Ring D (covered arena) will be available on Friday all day. On Saturday it will be set for Cross rails and at 10:00 am it will be restricted to Cross rail schooling only until classes begin in that arena. On Sunday schooling is available for crossrail riders only until 7:30 AM. After the conclusion of Ring D classes, the covered arena may be used for schooling. Lunging is permitted in the schooling rings and covered arena during off hours.

#### THERE WILL BE **NO** LUNGEING DURING HORSE SHOW HOURS.

#### **RESPONSIBILITY:**

Mountaineer Hunter Jumper Association, their membership and officers, herein after referred to as Management, and the WPQHA and their membership and officers, herein after referred to as WPQHA, will not be responsible for any damages to a person, animal or property at the WPQHA Show Complex for the MHJA Schooling Show, nor will Management and/ or WPQHA be responsible for any property lost or destroyed. 
